- Tips of USD 05 per person per day are compulsory in Hong Kong, Shenzhen and Macau for services of the guide and the driver. The same needs to be given to the Tour Manager on the first day. It will be applicable for an Adult/Child/Infant.
- Any damage caused to the hotel rooms or coach during the stay shall be payable by the passengers. Thomas Cook will not be liable for the same.
